

OUR INSPIRATION



The objective of Lala Jagat Naryan Educational Society, Jalalabad (W) is to establish and run educational, technical and professional institute for the promotion of education, particularly in this backward region of the State. To fulfill its aims and objectives, the society has established Lala Jagat Naryan Education College in the cherished memory of Lala Jagat Naryan, a freedom fighter, a fearless Journalist and social activist. Ancestors of Lala Jagat Naryan Diwan Mall Raj Chopra were trusted official of Shere Punjab Maharaja Ranjit Singh who resided in Wezirabad now in Pakistan. Lala Ji was born on 31st May 1899. He was the only son of Shri Lakhmi Das and Smt. Lal Devi, at British time his father was the S.H.O. (Thanedar) at Bikaner. Who left his job after being hurt due to unworthy behavior of British Police officers. He passed his matriculation in 1816 and he joined D.A.V. College Lahore where he was greatly inspired by the his Principal Mahatma Hans Raj Ji. The Jallianwala Bagh massacre affected Lala Jagat Naryan and he joined freedom struggle on the call of Mahatma Gandhi in 1920. In 1924 he worked as the editor of Akash Vani a paper started by Bhai Parma Nand, Besides this he also contributed articles to other papers such as the "Milap" and the partap later on, he set his press at Lahor. Lala ji participated in all Satya Grah movements launched by the congress under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi and was in Jail for about nine years on different occasions. His wife and other members of the family also suffered on account of their participation in the freedom movement. He built up great institution of the Hind samachar group of newspapers. These news papers have a distinct personality of their own. The Journalistic courage that lala ji had shown was most remarkable. It endeared the papers and him to the people. To protect the integrity of India lala ji used both his pen and voice and earned himself great fame. A significant fact in his journalistic achievement is that his fearless crusade against the force is disunity in Punjab made the communal force in the state fear his pen.



GENERAL RULES

1. No one who is in employment for whole time, part time or honorary service shall be allowed to join B.Ed. Course without taking leave from his/her institution office etc. from the date of commencement of the academic session up to the university final exam.
2. All the students are required to attend not less than 75% of the lectures delivered in each subjects otherwise their Roll No. shall be withheld and they will not be allowed to appear in the annual university exams.
3. Use of intoxicated substance are prohibited in the college campus.
4. Indiscipline and misconduct in all cases shall be dealt with severely. Even the student can be rusticated from the college.
5. All the students shall take part in co-curricular activities in the college.
6. All the students are required not to deface the walls an furniture etc. by writing slogan or otherwise.
7. All the students shall read the notices carefully placed on various notice boards from time to time and will not temper with them.
8. Mobile phones are not allowed in the college campus.
9. All the students must wear his/her identity card issued by the college otherwise he/she will not be allowed to enter the premises.
10. Political demonstrations and meetings are strictly prohibited in the college premises.
11. Students have to keep their college neat and clean. No student can pluck the flowers and spread dirt in the college.
12. Students are advised to utilize their free time/free period if any by visited the library.
13. All the students are required to be present in the morning assembly. It will be conducted rotation wise by different Sadans. Attendance of the students will be marked in the morning assembly.



FEATURES OF COLLEGE

Library:-

The college has got a well- equipped and well –furnished Library, situated in a newly constructed building. It has got more than 15,000 books having text books, reference books, and encyclopedia, Journals and daily news papers. Library remains open from 9.30 am to 4.30 pm and it also remains open during the vacations. The ambience of the library is specially designed to facilities the young scholars in learning. Rules and regulation concerned information in for getting books can be obtained from college librarian.

Computer Labs:-

Lala Jagat Naryan Education College focuses on a study of computer and its role in the applied environment. There are three well equipped computer labs. Consisting of 90 computers, as well as internet facility to impart quality education of highest standards to upcoming computer literates and to serve society and nation at large through education programmes.

Languages Lab :-

Subjects Combinations:-

(i) Admission to the B.Ed. course will be subjects based. At the time of admission each candidate shall opt two teaching subjects. A candidate can opt only those teaching subjects which he she has studied at graduate level.

(ii) Candidates who have passed additional subjects at graduate level must ensure that they are opting only those teaching subjects, marks of which are taken into account for the purpose on calculating the percentage of marks and eligibility.

Science:-

- (i) Medical group Science Language
- (ii) Non-medical group Physical Science/Science with Mathematics or Language

Humanities and Others:-

- (i) Any one subject studied at graduation level with languages.
- (ii) Physical education with languages.
- (iii) Music with languages.



EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. In above said subject combinations, first mentioned subject is the major one and later mentioned subject(s) is/are minor. The candidate should have studied the major subjects for full three years at graduation level or for two years at master level however minor subjects should have been studied for at least one year at graduation level. Admission to B.Ed. will be done in the above said subject combinations on the basis of merit in the respective colleges.
2. The candidates shall be given the required subject combination depending upon the seats available in the respective colleges.
3. A candidate can claim more than one subject combinations if he/she is eligible for the same.
4. Teaching of social studies shall be opted by the graduate who have taken up any two any two of the following subjects at B.A./M.A. level.



GENERAL RULES

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2. All the students are required to attend not less than 75% of the lectures delivered in each subjects otherwise their Roll No. shall be withheld and they will not be allowed to appear in the annual university exams.
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IS FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT OR MISBEHAVIOR

Attendance

The students on roll of the college are expected to be regular in attendance. The principal is fully competent to remove a student from the rolls of the college if he/she is habitually irregular in attendance. Further the students are required to be punctual in attending every period and late comers will not be marked present although they may be permitted to enter the class by the teacher concerned at her/his discretion.

1. A student habitually irregular in attendance and negligent in studies may be asked to leave the college at any time during the course of session.
2. According to the University rules, every student is required to attend at least 75% of lectures delivered in each subject.
3. Those who fail to attend the required number of lectures or fail to get a clear pass in the house examination will not be eligible to sit in the annual university examination. The condonation of shortage in attendance by the principal, in accordance, with university rules will be considered in aspect of those students only whose reports about studies and conduct is satisfactory.
4. If the students name is struck off the rolls of the colleges after his/her admission from the college for the University Examination has been set up, for nonpayment of dues or for any other reason, his or her admission from will be withdrawn by the principal and no notice to this effect will be given to the student or his/her guardian.
5. The names of the students who fail to clear their dues may be removed from the rolls of college.
6. The college office prepares date wise absence record of each student. The parents/guardian are advised to be in touch with the administrative office whether their wards are regular in attending classes or not. They must visit the college office at least once in a month. To check up the progress of their wards in studies and particularly in attendance of lectures.

SCHOLARSHIPS, STIPENDS RULES AND CONCESSIONS

The following scholarships and stipends are available to the deserving students :-

1. The Government, University, Military, Govt. of India, Post Metric. Scholarships to scheduled caste/scheduled tribe, state Govt. stipend to Backward class.
2. Merit Scholarships and National scholarships of Central state Govt. for the poor and brilliant students.
3. Merit scholarships for the children of primary and secondary school teacher.
4. Stipends by the Government for grant of education facilities to the children of political sufferers.
5. A few stipends to the needy and deserving students from students aid fund.
6. Besides, a large number of fee concessions and stipends are awarded by the Principal to the poor and deserving students on the basis of merit in studies, sports and cultural activities.
7. Lala Jagat Narayan Education Society provides pension schemes to widows every month.



FEE CONCESSION

1. The application for the concession and free ship for scheduled caste and backward class should be made on prescribed from at the time of admission. No such application shall be entertained later on.
2. The applicants for fee concession would be interviewed by a committee appointed by the Principal, Names of such students as are granted concession will be duly notified.
3. Fee concession/stipends/scholarships is liable to be withdrawn without a warning if a student deteriorates in studies, remains irregular with university rules will be considered in respect of those students only whose report about studies and conduct is satisfactory.

LEAVE RULES

1. Ordinary leave is granted to student teachers during the course of the training.
2. A serious notice taken of those students who remain absent from the college or from the practicing schools.
3. Leave, on ground of illness, for more than three days must be certified by a competent medical authority.
4. Absence from the house examination is taken very seriously and the defaulter is fined according to the university norms. Application for exemption on medical ground should accompany with a medical certificate issued by competent medical authority.
5. If a student does not attend the college within a week of the opening day, his/her admission shall be cancelled without serving any notice.
6. If a student remains continuous absent for seven days without leave during the session his/her name will be struck off from the college rolls.

RULES FOR PAYMENT OF DUES

1. If the student leave the college during the session. She will have to pay the fee for the whole period except in case of migration.
2. All the dues shall be paid at the college office on the specified dates which shall be duly notified.
3. Fees and other charges once paid shall not be refundable.
4. In the case of change of teaching subjects fee will be charged.
5. Name of the defaulter will be struck off the rolls on the 10th day of the due date for payment. A student whose name struck off for nonpayment of dues may be readmitted with the permission of the principal along with readmission fees.
6. Extension in the date of payment of dues may be granted by the principal in exceptional cases. Application for extension must be submitted to the principal in duplicate before the date on which the payment of fee is due.
7. A student absent or on leave from the college must arrange to pay her dues on the due dates.
8. If a student does not withdraw his/her name from the college rolls by applying on the withdraw from, she will be treated as on the rolls of the college for the purpose of realization of dues.
9. College fee/annual charges paid are non refundable.
10. If a student wishes to withdraw her name from the college she must do so in writing and her application must be counter signed by the parents or guardians who got his/her admitted.
11. Until their names are formally withdrawn, students are liable to pay all the college dues and fines.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

1. College uniform is compulsory for 5 days in a week. Only Saturday student may wear colorful dresses. White uniform is compulsory on every Wednesday. The students are not allowed to enter the college with Kurta and Pajama.
2. The college uniform is compulsory for all the students, Students are advised to ensure that they will come to the college in proper uniform.
3. As long as a student is on the college rolls he/she must always come to college in proper uniform also during the theory and practical exams.
4. No student will allow attending any college function or outside the college in any dressing other than college uniform.


CHANGE OF SUBJECT

A student may apply for the change of teaching subject without any penalty within fifteen days of the commencement of the session and with a penalty up to month, thereafter subject to the availability of the seats and at her own risk regarding the shortage of lectures. The student must note that lectures attended in the previous subject will not be taken into consideration. The principal can exercise her discretion regarding the change of subject.

HOUSE EXAMINATION

To assess the progress of the students will hold house examination during the year. The students are expected to prepare themselves well for the examination and show good results of the examination will ensure success in the University Examinations. The dates of the examination would be notified well in time. In addition to the examination, short class tests may be held by the teacher concerned.
